Who is Eligible?

This program is available to adults over 18 years of age who are already living independently or transitioning into independent living and require life skill support to function successfully in the community.



How Long Does it Last?

A person can receive supported living through Access Services indefinitely with the appropriate funding, as long as there is an exceptional level of need for the supports or until the individual feels they have achieved their own personal goals with the program.

How Do I Get Started?

A call to your county case management can begin the process. Optionally, supported living services may also be privately paid and secured with a direct call to Access Services.
